Dr. Alfred Baker 25th Annual Highlights of Recent Scientific Liver Meetings: Impact on Clinical Practice

Course Director: Daniel R. Ganger, MD, FAST, FAASLD, AGAF, FACP

Due to the highly complex nature of liver disease, it is essential to stay informed and up-to-date on the most recent developments in order to maximize patient outcomes. Some patients are being referred too late, when transplantation has become the only option. Additionally, there is a significantly greater risk of mortality in patients with liver disease who have multiple comorbidities. Finally, alcohol intake has increased during the pandemic and strategies are lagging behind and screening for liver cancer is inadequate in the US.

This educational program is focused toward healthcare professionals, including attending physicians, trainees, nurses, APPs and other healthcare providers caring for patients with liver disease. In a six-hour session, important information presented at the recent meeting of the American Association for the Study of Liver Diseases will be reviewed. Nine areas of clinical Hepatology will be covered and potential changes in patient management will be discussed.

PROGRAM OBJECTIVES

After attending this educational activity, participants should be able to:

- 1) Apply an evidence-based approach to the management of liver disease patients in both a hospital and an office setting.
- 2) Identify treatment challenges in liver disease patients with metabolic syndrome.
- 3) Define current standard treatments for patients with hepatitis B, C, NASH, alcoholic liver disease, portal hypertension and hepatocellular carcinoma.
- 4) Discuss the current state of liver transplantation and the management of liver transplant patients.
