## CRITICAL CARE PRECOURSE

### PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Seventy-five percent of hospitalists now care for patients in the Intensive Care Unit, indicating a pressing need for competency-based education targeted at the management of critically ill patients. The goal of the pre-course is to provide clinically relevant evidence-based updates on essential components of critical care including sepsis, acute respiratory distress syndrome, and liberation from mechanical ventilation.

### LEARNING OBJECTIVES

At the conclusion of this activity, participants will be able to:

1. Describe an evidence-based approach to the diagnosis and management of patients with severe sepsis and septic shock;
2. Demonstrate the ability to set, adjust, and troubleshoot the mechanical ventilator;

4. Describe the unique challenges of caring for critically ill patients with COVID-ARDS;
