- Describe the new EPR guidelines regarding asthma control
- Recognize when to step up treatment plans for early asthma exacerbations
- Compare hearing screening and hearing protection protocols for patients at risk for or with known hearing loss (such as those with cochlear implants, cleft and craniofacial anomalies, tinnitus, musicians)
